Certainly from our perspective as local directors of the work of Child Evangelism Fellowship® in County Armagh we give God all the glory for the great things that He has been doing in the lives of the children. We too are thankful for so many people who are labouring away silently behind the scenes in the quiet place, faithfully praying for the children and the plans that are being put into effect in the area. God has been hearing your prayers and answering. The schools ministry has been expanded and blessed. New openings came to go into Mount Norris primary School, to conduct assemblies, and Lurgan Junior High to take the Scripture Union.

The numbers at the Junior Youth Challenge have stabilised with about seven young people meeting together every fortnight to be taught from the Word of God. Twenty four young people from Armagh joined with Mourn area and attended the JYC weekend in Kilkeel where they received teaching on the Christian Soldier. It was a challenging weekend where the young people were compelled to enlist by putting their trust in the Lord Jesus Christ alone for salvation and then engage in fighting the good fight.

The regular teacher training class has been an encouragement to us with, on average, twelve Good News Club® teachers meeting together to pray for all aspects of their ministry and receive helps and a demonstration of a Bible lesson. In mid January we held a training morning for Good News Club Helpers which was really well received. Sixteen young people came along to be trained in General Preparation, How to prepare and teach as memory verse, How to conduct a quiz and Music with a message. The feedback we received has all been very positive. Darren commented on the day *"I thought the day was very good, interesting and instructive. I am glad I attended and have learned much by attending it about how to help in a G.N.C."*

We are still continuing to establish links with the local churches and over the past months we had wonderful opportunities to visit with a number of churches to promote the work and share our vision and burden for the children. We too are thankful to many who support the ministry financially who give freely back to the Lord as He has blessed them. The ministry cannot continue or grow without your help; to produce, print and post the prayer letters each year it costs on average of £1,300 per year and that is only one small expense per year. We are blessed by the fact that our prayer letter goes into around 750 homes each quarter, as that is a wonderful



foundation of prayer that has been well established. But if every person who received our prayer letter gave only £5 per month, or sixty pounds a year that would give us a total income of £45,000 per year. That would be enough to finance two areas in the north or South of Ireland for a year without having to worry about finance or raising any more support.
